Individual Cases – Dialysis Aid

In the second quarter of 2018, our Dialysis Aid Program supported 28 kidney patients who are either low income earners or unemployed due to their medical condition, compared to 21 supported cases within the same period in 2017. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM130 to RM1,000 per month for a period of six (6) months or more to ease their burden. Special thanks to Persatuan Yee Lan, Sungai Buloh for supporting 13 of our beneficiaries and to Yayasan Kossan for their continued support to fund 5 of our beneficiaries, from Feb 18 to Jul 18. Monthly Household Income: RM3,000 RM3,500 NG KAH YOK @ HWANG PAIK YIK

Madam Ng is a 77-year-old dialysis patient who is separated from her husband. Her eldest daughter takes care of her. During our recent visit in June 2018, her daughter now works overtime to increase her income to RM3,500 monthly. Madam Ng had applied for MOH subsidies in April 2018 and is currently waiting for approval.

MURUGAN A/L RAGAVAN

Murugan is a hardworking 39 years old man who was diagnosed with kidney disease at an early age. Despite his sickness, he worked hard as a freelance truck driver. He earns around RM1,000 while his factory worker wife earns a further RM1,200. They have a high school-going child. He is continuing his treatment so that he could live and provide for his children.

TOH SOK HOI

Madam Toh is a 57-year-old dialysis patient housewife. Her husband used to own a fish-ball business, where he wholesales to the restaurants, but is no longer able to continue his business after his recent heart surgery. Madam Toh is continuing her dialysis treatment with our RM720 monthly subsidy since the previous quarter.

LIEW TZER GIO

Liew is a 33 years old insurance agent and suffers from high blood pressure, kidney disease, and anaemia. We had previously supported him for 2 years. Despite his condition, he took on an additional role as a Grab driver to increase his income to RM1,700. He is continuing his treatment with our monthly RM720 subsidy.

LOW KAR WAI

Low, aged 39, used to work as a freelance script writer in film production. He has two kids aged 10 and 12. During our recent house visit in April 2018, he updated us that he had visited the panel doctor for his SOCSO assistance application and is now waiting for SOCSO assistance approval.





LOH YUN SHEONG

Mr Loh is 53 years old and has undergone dialysis treatment for more than 10 years. He requires epoetin injection for his treatment due to anaemia. His haemoglobin level is maintained between 7.1 to 7.4 during the assistance period. Without our support in epoetin injection, his blood level will fall critically.

THOO FONG MING

Madam Thoo is a 62 years old widow. We have been supporting Madam Thoo's dialysis cost for over a year, which used to total RM2,000. With the recent subsidy provided by the MOH, her monthly treatment cost has been reduced to RM130. She recorded an improved hemoglobin level of 10.6 in April 2018.







LOKE KAH SING

Loke Kah Sing is an OKU with hearing and sight disability. He injured both his legs when he fell from the stairs years ago and he needed to rely on a wheelchair ever since. He lives in a flat with his parents, aged 69 and 71, and they relied on his sister for household expenses. Sadly, Mr Loke had a heart attack in May 2018 and had passed away.

PASCHAL GOMEZ

Paschal Gomez is 77 years old and was diagnosed with Crohn's Disease when he was 30 years old and was further burdened with kidney failure last year. In our recent June 2018 visit, he told us that his 60 years old wife had given up one of her three jobs due to old age fatigue. Our assistance at least alleviates some of his family's burden.

SAMEY @ ANNASAMY A/L KANNAN

Mr Samey, age 71, suffers from diabetes, high blood pressure, and kidney disease. He was forced to amputate his leg due to diabetes and is now on a wheelchair with artificial limb for mobility. He is continuing his dialysis treatment with our RM720 monthly subsidy.





KUMARARAJA A/L SELVANATHAN

Mr Kumararaja is a kidney disease patient supported by his wife who works 12 hours daily in a semiconductor factory to cover their household expenses and his dialysis fee. In April 2018, Kumararaja has successfully submitted all the relevant documents to apply the subsidies from MOH and is waiting for approval.

NAGAMAH A/P GOPAL

Nagamah, 68 years old, is diagnosed with kidney failure and she is supported by her daughter. Madam Nagamah is showing signs of memory and dementia issues. Fortunately, her daughter is there for her. In April 2018, she has successfully submitted all the relevant documents to apply for MOH subsidies and is waiting for approval.



THANAPACKIAM A/P VEERABADHRAN

Madam Thanapackiam had worked as an office cleaner for 20 years and was diagnosed with kidney failure last year. Her medical expenses had always been borne by her sole daughter until she got married in December 2017. In May 2018, she shifted to Nilai to stay with her daughter. She will be receiving her dialysis treatment there and no longer requires GHCA's assistance.



LEDCHUMANAN A/L GURUNAIDU

Mr Ledchumanan is 64 years old and needs RM1,800 monthly to cover for his dialysis fees. His household expenses are catered by both his children. His condition has caused a financial and emotional strain to his family. Thankfully, he can continue his dialysis treatment with our RM720 monthly subsidy.



MUNIANDY A/L PALAR

Mr Muniandy 64 years old, used to work as a rubber tapper. His wife had utilised all her EPF savings for his dialysis fee, but it only lasted for a year. During our visit in May 2018, we found out that he recently had a fall in the dialysis centre and fractured his right leg. His wife is currently taking care of his daily needs.





POOMALAI A/L VELLASAMY

Mr Poomalai is 68 years old and is on dialysis treatment 3 times weekly. We had been supporting him RM720 monthly for his dialysis treatment for the past four years. With MOH's increased subsidies effective January 2018, his treatment now only costs RM260 monthly, and he is continuing his treatment with our support.

DEVINDRAN A/L MONIAM

Devindran is 35 years old and has walking complications. With MOH's increased subsidies in January 2018, his treatment cost has been reduced to RM130 monthly now. With our dialysis subsidy, we hope that he can focus on running his car wash business so that he can be financially independent.





LEE KAH CHUN

Mr Lee is only 30 years old but has been diagnosed with kidney failure, diabetes, and dry gangrene. He lives in pain every day, surviving on painkiller. During our visit in June 2018, he had amputated both his legs and one finger due to his condition. We hope that with our support, he can have some peace of mind and concentrate on improving his health condition.

GOPAL A/L SINNTHAMBY

Mr Gopal is an unemployed 62 years old man and needed RM1,890 monthly for his dialysis treatment fee. He is currently using his wife's EPF savings to cover their daily expenses and his haemodialysis treatment. He is continuing his dialysis treatment with our RM720 subsidy.



Mr Anandakumar was diagnosed with diabetes, where one of his leg was amputated. He and his wife survive solely on his SOCSO pension. GHCA successfully transferred him to the Waz Lian dialysis centre and fully sponsored his March and April 2018 treatment fees costing RM1,410 along with supplies of adult diapers and wet tissues. Sadly, in April 2018, he had a heart attack and passed away in his sleep.













Monthly Dialysis Expenses: RM2,880 RM840

MAH LAI MUN

Ms Mah suffers from blurred vision, diabetes and kidney failure in 2017. Her partner supported her by taking care of her during the day and working as a Grab car driver at night. Her monthly dialysis fee of RM2,880 was reduced to RM840 with GHCA's encouragement to apply for SOCSO's support.

CHEN SIEW CHIN

Madam Chen, 75 years old, has high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. She has 3 children, two of which had abandoned her, while another occasionally visits and fetches her to the dialysis centre but is unable to support her financially. Her relative provides shelter and daily meals for her. GHCA will be assisting her with RM720 monthly dialysis subsidy.

LAI SANG

Mr Lai is a 55 years old dialysis patient who worked as a part time painter. He was abandoned by his 3 children and is living in a dilapidated factory owned by his boss. He earned RM500 monthly and uses it for his daily meals. GHCA is supporting him with RM160 monthly dialysis subsidies.

YEONG MEE LIN

Madam Yeong is a 67 years old mother suffering from kidney failure, mild stroke, blurred vision, and knee pain. Her second daughter had migrated to Macau for work but provides her with RM800 monthly allowance. She relies on some support from Tzu Chi so GHCA decided to help her with RM720 monthly dialysis subsidy.

YONG KOON TAK

Mr Yong, 59 years old, suffers from diabetes, high blood pressure, heart ailment, and kidney failure. His wife, aged 57, worked as a clerk to support the family. Mr Yong's haemodialysis expenses of approximately RM2,000 monthly remained a huge burden for the family. Therefore, we are supporting Mr Yong with RM720 monthly subsidy.





CHONG CHUN ONN

Mr Chong, 36 years old, used to work as chef in Singapore, earning around S\$2300 monthly. When he found out he had high blood pressure (BP>200) and his kidney started to deteriorate, he gave up on his life and spent all his life savings on drinking, smoking, and gambling. In the end, he regretted his self-destructive actions and came back to Malaysia to seek hemodialysis treatment. GHCA is supporting him with RM720 monthly subsidy for his hemodialysis fee.

TAN LI CHIN

Madam Tan, aged 50, lives in a small house at Pulau Ketam. She had to take a ferry to Port Klang thrice weekly to receive hemodialysis treatment in Klang. It is very difficult for her to walk and travel every day because she has high blood pressure, diabetes, and heart ailment. Her second daughter has to quit her job to take care of her daily needs. Her husband worked as a fisherman, and her other children are working hard to support her treatment fee.



SIEW NEN FOO

Mr Siew, 49 years old, works as an administrator in an NGO. He was diagnosed with kidney failure and Hepatitis B a few months ago and is agonised by the expensive haemodialysis treatment fees in June 2018, as his MOH subsidy has been stopped. Meanwhile, he had submitted all the necessary documents to apply for SOCSO assistance in May 2018. GHCA decided to assist him monthly with RM720 subsidy for his hemodialysis treatment until his SOCSO assistance application is approved.

Individual Cases – Family Care

In the second quarter of 2018, we have reached out to 34 underprivileged families, compared to 20 families within the same period in 2017. Special thanks to Hong Leong Foundation, Project Cabel, and Cari Online Media for funding 25, 5, and 2 beneficiaries respectively in quarter 2, as per follow:

Monthly Income: RM1,200 RM1,400 CHELVAN A/L MUTHOO

Mr Chelvan, a 55-years-old divorcee, recently obtained employment as a contract security guard, earning RM1,200 but working 12 hours a day. During our visit in May 18, his eldest son had successfully found a job and is now providing Chelvan with RM200 monthly allowances.

DAYANIDHI A/L ARUMUGAM SHANMUGAM

Dayanidhi is an 11-year-old boy diagnosed with cerebral palsy and he is unable to move, speak, or eat. He is only able to consume PediaSure milk as his diet. During our April 2018 visit, his KISS programme application had been approved and now he has an extra RM200 monthly to support his household expenses.

DESTINY STARTING POINT

This is an old folks and disability centre with 46 residents, which were previously in need of groceries such as vegetables and fishes. During our May 18 visit, they have managed to stabilise their groceries supplies and therefore no longer requires our assistance.

DEVI A/P MUNIANDY

Devi is a single mother working as a plantation estate worker, earning RM1,000 monthly. During our visit in June 2018, she is currently looking for other job opportunities as she plans to resign from her work and move out from the plantation estate due to some personal matters.

LACHEMY A/P PERISAMY

Madam Lachemy was a single, unemployed, 67years-old lady who suffers from diabetes, high blood pressure, and depression. She takes care of her two sisters, aged 70 and 77, and has found an office cleaning job earning RM850 monthly. During our May 2018 visit, her sisters have moved to their relative's house. Thus, she can free up some of her expenses.











Monthly Income: RM800 RM1,000

LALITHA A/P RAMAN

Madam Lalitha is a single mother who lives with her only daughter. She runs a small nasi lemak stall near her flat. After our 3 months assistance, Lalitha has shown improvement in her nasi lemak business as she commenced nasi lemak delivery starting April 2018 and earned an extra RM200 monthly.

LOH CHOONG WEI

Choong Wei, aged 7, suffers from epilepsy and is the grandson of Madam Thoo Foong Ming, one of our beneficiaries for kidney dialysis subsidies. Support for his diapers and milk powder is still ongoing for the quarter under review.

NEROSHA A/P KRISHNAN

Nerosha is a young girl who met with a horrible motor accident in February 2014. She had bowel and perineal injuries, and her intestine was dislodged outside her body. She now needs to use colostomy bag to pass motion for the rest of her life. Support is still ongoing for Nerosha for her monthly purchase of 3 colostomy bags.

NG CHING MEE

Madam Ng is a 63-years-old frail lady and is taken care of by her single daughter. During our recent visit in May 2018, her health condition is getting worst, as her osteoporosis combined with backbone spinal compression had deeply anguished her. Her daughter is trying to look for a better medical treatment for her.

NG JOE ZE

Joe Ze is 11 years old and has learning disability. He lives in a family of 10 with his 7 siblings, father, mother, and grandmother. Joe Ze was admitted to the hospital and quarantined for suspected H1N1 in March. Therefore, he did not attend his tuition classes for 2 months. He had resumed his tuition class in May 2018 and we are hoping that these tuition classes could help him improve academically.











PARAMESWARY A/P RAJINDRA

Madam Parameswary has two children, with one having Down Syndrome and requires extra care. She works as a tailor and part time home cleaner. In our June 2018 visit, she lost her part-time laundry shop cleaner job as the shop runs into financial trouble. GHCA had assisted her to apply for aid from the Social Welfare Department and we hope that her application gets approved.

SARAVANAN A/L SIVALINGAM

Mr Saravanan is a severe diabetes and cataract patient who suffered a serious fall down the stairs. GHCA has been providing transportation subsidy for his travel to the hospital for treatment. Unfortunately, after 6 months of treatment, his leg still has not shown any improvement, due to his diabetes condition. His leg might not be able to recover completely.

SEONG YOKE SIM

Madam Seong, 87-years-old, is bed-ridden and has high blood pressure. Her single mother daughter takes care of her along with three primary-school-going children. During our visit in June 2018, her physical condition improved, as her back wound had recovered. She is now able to consume light food.

TAN HOCK CHUAN

Mr Tan works as a part-time welder. During our visit in June 2018, he informed that he has changed job and now works as a daily wage helper in a renovation company, earning up to RM900 monthly. His wife has also found an additional job as a house cleaner, earning RM320 monthly. Both are working hard to provide a better future for their 3 children.

TEE GIAP SIANG

Mr Tee, 28-years-old, injured his head in a serious car accident two years ago, making him paralysed and bed-ridden for life. He could not speak nor eat and is fed milk via a feeding tube connected to his stomach. In our June 2018 visit, Mr Tee has shown improvement in his condition. He is now able to shake his legs, turn his head, and move his eyes to follow object movements.











THERESAMAH A/P SAMUEL PILLAI

Madam Theresamah 64-years-old, stays with her retired husband and relied on her husband's pension for a living. In our June 18 visit, her vision is getting blurred due to diabetes. GHCA will be increasing our subsidies to RM300 monthly for her to buy 2 tins of Nutren diabetic milk as diet to better manage her diabetes level.

RANJIT KAUR AP KARTAR SINGH

Madam Ranjit, 56-years-old, is a mentally ill stroke patient. She is staying with her younger sister, who has 5 children, has frequent headache, and unable to work as she faints occasionally. 7 of them are relying on Social Welfare Department aid. GHCA sponsored a wheelchair for Ranjit and groceries support of RM300 for 6 months.

YAP YONG HUI

Mr Yap, aged 41, has kidney failure, diabetes, and high blood pressure. We engaged him as supplier for GHCC's Lunch Box for the Hungry program, and further assist him with RM300 groceries support. Unfortunately, he passed away in June due to cerebral hemangioma. His support will be transferred to his mother, Lee Poh Yok, who would be taking over the lunch box business.

GAMMALA A/P P MUNISAMY

Madam Gammala, 65 years old, is a single mother with 2 mentally disabled children. She has high blood pressure and frequently falls sick. Despite her illness, she must take care of her children. They relied on Social Welfare aid to pay for rental, utility bills, and medication. GHCA is supporting them with groceries supplies for 6 months.

Monthly Income: RM0 RM1,000 ALVIN A/L J RICHARD

Mr Alvin recently lost his job in April 2018 due to a hand injury in a work accident. His wife is unable to work as she must take care of their four children, aged 1, 3, 4, and 8. GHCA is supporting Alvin with RM300 monthly groceries subsidies for six months. With constant encouragement from our volunteers, he managed to find a job as a security guard in June 2018, earning RM1000.





CHUA AI KONG

Mr Chua, 63-years-old, is diagnosed with Parkinson disease. He used to be a fisherman, but now works together with her wife as a labourer to peel off shrimp skin. Due to old age, they could not commit long hours in their work, earning only RM10-20 daily. GHCA is supporting them RM150 monthly support their grocery supplies.

TOH BEE CHOO

Madam Toh, 41 years old, is a widow staying alone in her ancestral house. She worked as a labourer to peel shrimp skin, earning RM10-20 daily. She suffers from high blood pressure and could not commit long hours in work. GHCA is supporting her with RM150 worth of oatmeal and milk monthly to improve her health condition.

Elwin, 16 years old, is bed-ridden and suffers from muscular dystrophy and severe scoliosis. His mother, Gomathi A/P Ramasamy, is one of our beneficiaries in support of her nasi lemak business. To reduce his mother's burden, GHCA is supporting him RM150 for diapers and milk

supplies for six months.

ELWIN RAJ A/L A. EASTER

Mr David, 51 years old, is wheelchair-bound and had his right hand amputated. He has an 11 years old daughter. David sells handcraft souvenir in Batu Caves for a living. Every month, he spends over RM200 on his medical supplies. GHCA is assisting David with medical supplies subsidy RM200 for 6 months so they can afford to send their daughter for tuition classes.





GOMATHI A/P RAMASAMY

Madam Gomathi, is a 43 year old single mother of 2 children. One of her children has muscular dystrophy and is bed-ridden. We assisted her to start a nasi lemak stall to support her family's expenses. With the support, Gomathi is transformed from being unemployed to become a small business owner, earning RM1,500 monthly.











INDARANI A/P DARAMDASS

Madam Indarani is a 67-years-old widow with 5 sons who had abandoned her. She relies on a survivor's pension from her deceased husband to pay for her daily expenses. After six months of support, she is thankful for our groceries that helped her get through the difficult times when she has struggled with food.

Monthly Household Income: RM1,100 RM1,900

PATMANATHAN A/L ELLAPAN

Mr Patmanathan was diagnosed with diabetes, kidney failure, cataract, and had his leg amputated. He is unable to continue his previous work role due to his physical disability. In our May 2018 visit, his son, who was unemployed previously, had managed to find a job as an office dispatch, earning RM800 monthly.

T ANANDAKUMAR A/L THAMBIDURAI

Mr Anandakumar had passed away in April 2018 due to a heart attack. Therefore, we had transferred his groceries supplies support to his surviving wife, Madam Suseila A/P Velliah temporarily for the remaining months, hoping that our support can help her cope with the loss.

WONG WENG KEONG

Mr Wong had stroke after a car accident 25 years ago. He has head injuries and mobility issues that lead to unemployment. In April 2018, Mr Wong was met with another motor accident and hurt his legs. Fortunately, their relatives have approached them and will be supporting them from June 2018 onwards.

YAP EN BOO @ YAP AH MAI

Madam Yap, 71 years, suffers from diabetes and high blood pressure. She has 9 children, with 7 of them married but did not provide allowance to her. One of her son is taking care of her, together with her daughter which has Down Syndrome. GHCA had tried to help her daughter to look for work-at-home jobs but failed. We will be supporting them in groceries for 12 months.







NG SIEW KIAU

Madam Ng, aged 67, was diagnosed with epilepsy when she was young and has been unemployed for many years due to poor physical condition. She relies on Social Welfare aid to pay her rental and get her meals via GHCC's Lunch Box for the Hungry program. GHCA decided to subsidise her room rental for 1 year from June 2018 until May 2018 to reduce her financial burden.

LEE TA HONG

Madam Lee is a single mother with 8 children. She is selling prawn biscuits table by table in Bukit Tinggi area to support her household expenses. Her son is born with hemangioma, which causes his tongue to bleed and swell. He was seeking medical treatment in Hospital Kuala Lumpur in April, with GHCA supporting them RM150 as transportation subsidies to HKL. However, in May 2018, Madam Lee informed us that they have decided to stop the HKL treatment and will rely on Chinese herbs instead.

LEE PEI TENG

Madam Lee, 39 years old, was raised in a singleparent family by her mother. She had spinocerebellar ataxia (SCA) and it changed her life dramatically. She needs to rely on wheelchair for mobility, her speech is incoherent and unclear at times, and her hand and leg movement is unnatural. She is seeking free physiotherapy treatment in the SOCSO rehabilitation centre in Melaka. GHCA is supporting her with groceries support until September 2018.

Ad-Hoc Cases

In the second quarter of 2018, there were 12 underprivileged families that we assisted with ad-hoc emergency one-time funding. Special thanks to Hong Leong Foundation and CARI Online Media for providing the funding that enable us to assist these families.

LEE FOR THAI @ LEE FOH THAI

Madam Lee, aged 84, is bed ridden due to old age. In April 2018, GHCA had sponsored two times ambulance fee to transport Madam Lee to the hospital. This is because she is staying in an apartment without lift and requires professional healthcare assistance to bring her down from using stairs. Unfortunately, Madam Lee had passed away in her sleep in May 2018.

MARIAMAH AP ENKIAH

Mariamah, aged 81, slept on an uncomfortable wooden chair in the living room for years, as she could not afford a proper bed. She relied on her daughter and grandchildren for a living. Their income is only sufficient to cover minimal expenses. GHCA provided her with a bed and mattress so that she can sleep comfortably. During our visit in April 2018, she told us a good news that her granddaughter recently got a pay raise from RM800 to RM1200.











ALVIN A/L J RICHARD

Mr Alvin is one of our Family Care beneficiaries. We provided him with a one-time support of clothing, curtains, and bed sheets for his children when he was unemployed in April 2018. GHCA volunteers also helped to paint his whole house so that his family can stay in a more comfortable environment. Alvin and his family felt extremely happy and grateful from our help.

NORSHAM BINTI YAACOB

Madam Norsham, 43 years old, was a receptionist in a specialist clinic. She was forced to stop working due to necrosis of her lower limb. Her right lower limb had to be amputated in April of 2018. GHCA provided her with a wheelchair to ease her mobility post-operation while reducing her family's financial burden.

NG CHING MEE

Madam Ng is one of our Family Care beneficiaries. As her health condition deteriorated in May 2018, we further supported her with diaper supplies, nutritional herbs, and TCM treatment subsidy. Her daughter was forced to spend all her money to help her mother get better.

PATMANATHAN AL ELLAPAN

Mr Patmanathan is one of our Family Care beneficiaries. In June 2018, he went for an eye operation to treat cataract and needed a special cataract lens to wear post operation. We helped him to purchase the lens in a recommended pharmacy from Hospital Kuala Lumpur.

MAHESWARY A/P RAMASANDIRAN

Madam Maheswary is the cousin of our Family Care beneficiary, Saravanan A/L Sivalingam. She works as a school cleaner, earning RM1,000 monthly. Every afternoon, she rushes home to help Saravanan with his insulin injection, before going back to work. Their household expenses lie on her shoulder. In our June 2018 visit, she had 4 months of outstanding instalment for her motorcycle as her salary has been spent on rental. GHCA helped her pay the balance of her instalment, including insurance and road tax.











MUNIANDY A/L PALAR

Mr Muniandy is one of our Dialysis Aid beneficiaries. During our recent visit, he fell in the dialysis centre and fractured his right leg, causing him unable to walk. Therefore, GHCA helped him with a one-time support of diaper supplies, wet tissue supplies, and cereals to help ease his condition.

LEE KAH CHUN

Mr Lee is our Dialysis Aid beneficiaries. Both his legs and two fingers were amputated due to dry gangrene. Moreover, he was malnutrition due to the side effect of his medication. We provided him with a one-time supply of adult diapers, protein drinks, wet tissues, and 10 tins of Milo, as he can only take non-solid meals now, where solid meals make him throw up.

ZURAINI BINTI MOHAMAD AMIN

Madam Zuraini, 48-years-old, had been admitted to Hospital Kuala Lumpur for 2 months, going through six operations due to viral infection on her leg, which was amputated it in the end. We provided her with a walking frame and some supplies of diapers to help in her recovery and readjustment period.

TOH BEE CHOO

Madam Toh is our Family Care beneficiary. She has been wearing her old glasses for 5 years because she could not afford to get a new pair. Her old glasses are making her feel dizzy all the time. We brought her out from Pulau Ketam to let her choose a new pair of suitable glasses in Klang to solve her eyesight problem.

CHIANG HOE @ CHEONG AH HOW

Madam Chiang, 76-years old, is a rubbish collector in Kampar. She stays in her ancestral house that is without a toilet and basic furniture such as bed, wardrobe, and lightings. She always sleeps outside her house and urinate anywhere on the street. With help from Cari Online media team, we assisted her in building a toilet and stairwell armrest, repair her broken wall and cement flooring, provided basic furniture, and help clear up some rubbishes from her house.

Care Centres

MEDICATED OIL AND BLANKET DISTRIBUTION TO TIAM YAM TOH TENG OLD FOLKS

In collaboration with Sin Chew Daily, GHCA distributed medicated oil and blankets, sponsored by readers of the daily, to 30 elderlies aged 60-84 from Yam Toh Teng Old Folks Home with the objective to give care and love to the old folks. Volunteers also spent a chit-chatting session with the old folks.



MEDICATED OIL DISTRIBUTION TO RUMAH ORANG TUA SERI SETIA

20 GHCA volunteers went to the Rumah Orang Tua Seri Setia on 29 April 2018 to distribute medicated oil donated by readers of Sin Chew Daily to the elderly. 42 old folks, aged 62-92, benefited from the session. Volunteers spent quality time getting to know the old folks as well.

ORANG ASLI EMPOWERMENT PROJECT AT KAMPUNG ORANG ASLI MUADZAM SHAH

On 19 May 2018, GHCA did a follow-up visit to four Kampung Orang Asli in Muadzam Shah, Pahang for the Orang Asli Empowerment Project. A great thanks to Magnum 4D Berhad for sponsoring the project, which includes construction of 3 wells at Kampung Effendi, Kampung Atan, and Kampung Rima so that the villagers could get 20 gallons of clean water source for daily usage. The team also brought along teaching and educational materials to the learning centre in Kampung Simpai, that saw the place now being equipped with white board, tables, chairs, fans, television, lights, DVD player, stationaries, and books courtesy of the team. While volunteers were engaged with installing the television set, fans, and other electrical appliances in the study room, the children were reeling in excitement and could not wait to see what the new additions to their learning centre can do. We hope that a better learning environment is created with this round of support so that the reading interest among the Orang Asli children could be encouraged, because they too deserve for a chance at education.

Classes for the Children

In the second quarter of 2018, we had conducted 10 sessions of Malay and English language classes on Saturdays, attended by 193 students in total, averaging 19 students per session. We are currently renovating and expanding GHCC's classrooms so that we could facilitate more children to attend our weekly classes and give more space and comfort to the children enrolled in our classes. The renovation is expected to be completed in the third quarter of 2018.



Vegetable Garden for the Community

In the second quarter of 2018, we had a bountiful harvest as we managed to conduct 27 crop harvesting sessions, gathering 153.7kgs of vegetables that are distributed out to our neighbours and community surrounding GHCC. The vegetables grown this quarter consists of water spinach (kangkung), mustard loose-leaf (sawi), amaranth (bayam), white radish, and Hong Kong choy sum. Nearly 50 beneficiaries benefited from our vegetable garden every month, with some of the beneficiaries volunteering their time to help at our community garden.

GREAT VISION CHARITY ASSOCIATION

PRUkasih Program

PRUkasih is a free protection plan offered to urban low-income families that provides them with temporary financial relief to help the families cope with sudden loss of income due to illness, accident, or death. A brainchild between Prudential Assurance Malaysia Berhad and NGO Yayasan Generasi Gemilang, Great Vision Charity Association acts as a partner to deliver the program to the residents at PPR Pantai Ria.

In the quarter under review, 73 residents from 63 households have been successfully enrolled for the program via monthly recruitment drive and house visitation. A total of 18 claims related to illnesses, accidents, and death have been filed by the PRUkasih members, with RM19,120.00 worth of claims been approved for disbursement to the affected members.
