Individual Cases - Dialysis Aid

In the third quarter of 2024, our Dialysis Aid Program supported 39 kidney failure patients from the low-income or unemployed group, compared to 33 patients within the same period in 2023. Each patient receives a dialysis fee subsidy ranging from RM360 to RM1,000 per month to ease their burden. From these 39 beneficiaries, 3 are new cases. The beneficiaries listing is as follow:

HEW KEAT SOON

Mr. Hew, 45, a father of 3, lost his job due to kidney disease. His eldest daughter, breadwinner, struggled to support the family. In Sept 24, his Invalidity Pension application was still in process, and his burden grew as his brother diagnosed with cancer. GHCA extended his aid to ease his hardship.

ALVIN A/L ANNANDAN

Mr. Alvin, 43, a father of 1, a SOCSO aid recipient, is unable to work due to his health condition. In Jul 24, his wife's full-time job as a kitchen helper had become stable enough to manage the household expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our aid support.

PATHEMANI A/P KALIAPERUMAL

Mdm. Pathemani, 61, a MITRA aid recipient, faced frequent hospital admissions due to lung issues, leading to rising medical debts. Her son took up freelance welding to increase his income. Thus, GHCA extended our support till Nov 24 till his son's job stable.

MUHAMMAD AZLI BIN ABDULLAH

Mr. Azli, 30, single, currently bedridden due to a lower limb fracture, lives with his mother and depends solely on his Invalidity Pension and SOCSO. As of Jul 24, there were no updates from Zakat, and GHCA extended his aid till Oct 24 to support his recovery.

ROSITA BINTI MAHMUD

Mdm. Rosita, 50, a mother of 5, undergoes dialysis with a MAIM subsidy. In Aug 24, she stopped from single-use dialyzer, which significantly reducing her dialysis fees. With her family now able to manage the expenses, she no longer requires our support.

WONG KIM LOONG

Mr. Wong, 49, unemployed, divorced, and father of one, is a SOCSO aid recipient relying on JKM assistance. He struggles with treatment fees and still has outstanding debts at the dialysis center. GHCA extended his dialysis subsidy until Oct 24 while he seeks alternative support.

LAI LAN LIN

Mdm. Lai, 75, widowed, mother of 4, suffers from kidney failure and hypertension and receives a dialysis subsidy from MAZDA. In Aug 24, she informed GHCA that her children are now able to manage her dialysis expenses. Thus, she is no longer requires our support.

LIEW AH SANG

Mr. Liew, 75, widowed, suffers from cataracts, hypertension, high cholesterol, and kidney failure. He depends on his daughter, a single mother working as a waitress. In Aug 24, his health improved and applied for support from other NGOs. To ease their burden, GHCA extended his support.

SING THIAM HOCK

Mr. Sing, 65, single, lives with his two siblings. He suffers from kidney failure and schizophrenia. He a SOCSO aid recipient, relying on his sibling's JKM assistance. In Aug 24, his JKM application was approved, significantly easing his family's burden. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

MUHAMMAD IBNIL SHAHIR BIN MOHD ALI

Mr. Ibnil, 26, single, suffers from hypertension and kidney failure. He lives with his mother, who works as a babysitter. In Sept 24, he tried working as a Grab rider but faced challenges due to his unstable health condition. Therefore, GHCA extended its support while he continue to look for a suitable job.











ZULKARNAIN BIN NURUDDIN@NORDIN

Mr. Zulkarnain, 55, father of 3, suffers from high blood pressure, heart condition, and kidney failure and on SOCSO subsidy. In Jul 24, his health has improved, and his children is now able to manage his medical cost. Therefore, he no longer requires our support.

NADRAH BINTI MOHAMAD RIDZA

Mdm. Nadrah, 34, married, suffers from hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. She relies on her husband, a factory worker and SOCSO for a living. In Jul 24, despite no response from SUK, her family can manage her medical expenses. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

ROHANI BINTI AWANG

Mdm. Rohani, 59, single and lives alone. She relies on SOCSO, JKM and Zakat for his living expenses. In Jun 24, her Invalidity Pension application was approved, which significantly easing her financial burden. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

SITI FARIDAH BINTI MD KHAMARUDDIN

Mdm. Siti Faridah, 35, a mother of one, relies on SOCSO aid. In July 2024, despite Tzu Chi rejecting her application, her husband began freelance work, allowing them to manage expenses with JKM and her Invalidity Pension. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

VOONG CHIN EE

Mr. Voong, 56, divorced, suffers from high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. He replies on SOCSO aid and JKM. In Aug 24, he switched to a new dialysis center due to outstanding fees at his previous one. Thus, GHCA ended its dialysis support as he sought a new center.

LOW ENG JOO

Mr. Low, 72, father of 6, suffers from high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure. He relies solely on his married children for a living. In Aug 24, despite no updates from MOH or SUK, his family are able to manage his dialysis fees. Thus, he no longer requires our support.













THENG CHON FAH

Mr. Theng, 61, father of 1, suffers from high blood pressure, high cholesterol, diabetes, and kidney failure while earning a living through freelance pipework. In Aug 24, his government aid subsidy applications were rejected due to incomplete documents. Therefore, GHCA extended its support.

MARIAM BINTI ABU BAKAR

Mdm. Mariam, 74, mother of 1, suffers from hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. Both she and her husband were retirees, while her daughter, married with children, had her own family to support. Mdm. Mariam passed away on Aug 24, thus GHCA ended its support.

WONG KOK WAI

Mr. Wong, 52, father of 2, suffers from hypertension and kidney failure. His wife, breadwinner, working at a hawker stall selling noodles. In Sept 24, Nanyang Press would be providing assistance to cover his dialysis fees. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

HASZAMAN BIN HASSAN

Mr. Haszaman, 52, father of 3, suffers from hypertension, diabetes, and kidney failure. He relies on SOCSO aid, and his wife, breadwinner, works as a saleswoman for a living. In Sept 24, he switched to single-use dialyzer, which significantly reduced their expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

ARUNMOZHI A/P MARIMUTHOO

Mdm. Arunmozhi, 59, mother of 3, suffers from hypertension, diabetes, high cholesterol, and kidney failure relies on SOCSO aid her son, a Grab driver, whose income is insufficient to cover her dialysis cost. Therefore, GHCA extended her dialysis aid while her son looks for full-time job.

LAM KONG FOON

Mr. Lam, 73, married, suffers from hypertension and kidney failure. He relies solely on his married son, a salesman, whose income is insufficient to cover his dialysis fees. In Sept 24, there was still no update from MOH for his subsidy application. Thus, GHCA extended its aid.













ARIZAL BIN KAMARUDDIN

Mr. Arizal, 31, father of 2, suffers from hypertension and kidney failure, and relies solely on his parents for support and ZAKAT. His SOCSO application was approved in Jun 24, but he still struggles to cover the remaining dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA extended its aid while he applies for additional assistance.

MOHD NOR HAKIM BIN MANAN

Mr. Hakim, 50, a father of 3, depends on SOCSO aid, his invalidity pension, and his wife, who works as a factory worker for a living. In Jul 24, his daughter's job as a factory worker has stable and allowed the family to manage his dialysis fees. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

MATHIALAGAN A/L SANTHIRAN

Mr. Mathialagan, 47, father of 1, depends on SOCSO aid, his invalidity pension, and his wife, who works as a Sales Marketer. In Jul 24, his son began his tertiary studies in Culinary Arts, and they adjusted their finances, allowing them to self-sustain. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

BASKARAN A/L ARIVALAGAN

Mr. Baskaran, 30, orphan, suffers from kidney failure, works part-time as a Machine Operator and receives SOCSO aid but struggles with dialysis fees. In Jul 24, there was still no update on his Invalidity Pension application, and he had applied for JKM assistance. Therefore, GHCA extended his aid.

RAVICHANDRAN A/L GOPAL

Mr. Ravichandran, 49, separated from his family, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. He works as a temple cleaner and struggles with dialysis fees. In the latest update, he was still working on his SUK application. Therefore, GHCA extended to provide support.

MOHD AFFENDY BIN ABDUL HAMID

Mr. Affendy, 51, father of 4, breadwinner, suffers from kidney failure and works as Admin Assistant. He receives SOCSO aid and despite no updates from SUK, he informed that he had readjusted his finances and was able to manage the medical fees. Thus, he no longer requires our support.













HAM AH KIM

Mdm. Ham, 52, a single mother of 1, suffers from kidney failure. She replies to her daughter, work as an Administrator, for her dialysis fees. In Aug 24, her KKM application was approved to subsidise her dialysis costs. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

LOGESWARI A/P RAJA RATNAM

Mdm. Logeswari, 46, single, works as a security guard, receives SOCSO aid but struggled to cover her dialysis fees. In Aug 24, there was still no update on her NGO dialysis center application. Currently, her sister can support her dialysis fees. Thus, she no longer requires our support.

LEE KIM YEW

Mr. Lee, 54, single, unemployed, relies on SOCSO and JKM aid. He is partially blind and lives with his mother. In the latest update, his health remains unstable. He is planning to withdraw his EPF money next year to cover his medical fees. Thus, GHCA extended his support.

SEELAN A/L NAVANAYAGAM

Mr. Seelan, 36, single, suffers from high blood pressure, diabetes, and kidney failure. His health issues have affected his eyesight, making him unable to work. He depends on his family for support. In Aug 24, his Invalidity Pension was approved. Thus, he no longer requires our support.

LIEW TZER GIO

Mr. Liew, 41, suffers from kidney failure. He depends solely on his part-time job as an administrator and struggles to manage his dialysis fees. In Sept 24, he applied for aid from JKM and Tzu Chi and and waiting for response. Thus, GHCA has extended our support.

FOO YEW CHOY

Mr. Foo, 63, father of 1, and his wife both suffer from kidney failure. He currently works as a Grab driver, while his daughter is an online vendor. In Jul 24, he applied for aid from Tzu Chi and waiting for response. Therefore, GHCA extended our support till Oct 24.







NG YEE LI

Mdm Ng, 47, married, replies on SOCSO aid, her Invalidity Pension and her husband, work as a Site Supervisor. In Jul 24, she is still in the process of applying for support from other NGO dialysis centers. Therefore, GHCA extended our support till Oct 24.

ZAIRULNIZA BINTI AZIZUL

Mdm Zairulniza, 44, mother of 6, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure, relies solely on her husband, a personal driver, who struggles to cover her dialysis fees. Despite receiving SOCSO aid, it remains insufficient. Thus, GHCA extended her aid while she applied for an Invalidity Pension.

WONG CHEW YUET

Mdm Wong, 68, suffers from high blood pressure and kidney failure. Currently, she is living with her children and solely relies on them for living. Her second child works as a lorry driver and struggles to cover her dialysis fees. Thus, GHCA extended her support while she applied for MOH aid.

GANESAN A/L ODAYAPPEN

Mr. Ganesan, 71, suffers from high blood pressure, a history of stroke, and kidney failure. His wife and eldest son struggle to cover his dialysis fees while bearing the household expenses and supporting the studies of his two other children. Thus, GHCA extended his support while he applied for MITRA.

In the third quarter of 2024, we assisted 36 underprivileged families, compared to 35 supported cases within the same period in 2023. 8 of these families are new cases this quarter. The beneficiaries listing is as follow:

Mr. Krishna, 42, leg amputee, receives a full subsidy for dialysis from SOCSO and an NGO. While he relies on JKM aid, he struggles with transport costs to the dialysis center. In Sept 24, he applied for transport aid from another NGO, but the application was denied. Thus, GHCA extended transport support.

NOR LIZAH BINTI ABDUL NAZER

Mdm. Lizah, 53, a divorced mother of six, worked as a part-time cleaner. With the support of JKM and MAIM aid, she's able to managed her household expenses and expressed heartfelt gratitude for two years of GHCA rental assistance. Thus, she no longer requires our aid.

ALEX SANTHANA A/L ANTHONY

Mr. Alex, 35, is recovering after donating part of his liver to his daughter, who suffered from liver failure. Last quarter, as the family's sole breadwinner, he secured a job as a personal driver, enabling him to support his family. Thus, he no longer requires our grocery aid.

RAMASAMY A/L PERUMAL

Mr. Ramasamy, 70, father of 4, suffers from kidney failure and relies on dialysis treatment. In Aug 24, his daughter informed GHCA that she would take over managing the household and able to manage the expenses. Thus, he no longer requires our medical aid.

THAVAMANI DEVI A/P BALAKRISNAN

Mdm. Thavamani, 35, single mother of 4, suffers from stage 4 cancer, struggles to provide for her children while undergoing chemotherapy. In Aug 24, her health worsened, and she was admitted to the hospital. Therefore, GHCA extended grocery aid to ease her worries about her children.











PUVANESWARY A/P SUPPAYA

Mdm Puvaneswary, 39, underwent major surgery and she was unable to work. Her husband works as a dispatcher to support the family. In Sept 24, they are now able to better manage their own expenses. Thus, she no longer requires our grocery support.

BAVITHRA A/P R.ELLANKO

Mdm Bavithra, 33, mother of 1, faced rental struggles after losing her nursing job due to a wrist injury, while her husband works as a contractor. In Jul 24, her health improved, and she managed to secure a nursing job. Thus, she no longer requires our rental aid.

NURUL NABILA BINTI JUNWARI

Mdm Nabila, 34, single mother of 2, suffer from diabetes and solely relied on MAIM and JKM aid for living. In Jul 24, she informed us that she now be able to manage household expenses with help from her relatives. Thus, she no longer requires our grocery aid.

USHA A/P THESIGAMANY

Mdm Usha, 37, mother of 3, with one child suffering from kidney failure. In Jul 24, her husband started working as a freelance technician, allowing them to better manage their household expenses. AThus, she no longer requires our grocery aid.

PARIMALA A/P SUBRAMANIAM

Mdm Parimala, 42, divorced, mother of 1. Her 15-year-old son who constant care due to kidney failure and nutritional deficiencies. Last quarter, her son's condition improved, allowing her to better manage the household expenses. Thus, she no longer requires our grocery aid.

PUNITHA A/P RAMACHANDRAM

Mdm Punitha, 46, single mother of 3, solely relies on BINGKAS aid after the passing of her husband last year. In Aug 24, her derivative pension was approved, allowing her to manage the household expenses. Thus, she no longer requires our rental aid.











MUHAMMAD ARIIZ RIZZKI

Ariiz, 2, is healthy. His mother, divorced, and Ariiz have been temporarily staying with his aunt. Unfortunately, last quarter, despite several attempts to reconnect, our team were unable to reach them. Thus, GHCA concluded its support after August 2024

SUMETHE A/L WICKAMASANA

Mr. Sumethe, 62, divorced, suffers from knee pain and psoriasis. He solely relies on JKM aid for his living expenses and struggles to afford groceries. In May 24, his psoriasis condition worsened. Therefore, GHCA extended his grocery aid till Nov 24 while he recovers.

THAMARAI A/P T.IVARU

Mdm. Thamarai, 53, single mother of 2, suffers from diabetes. She works as a part-time cleaner but struggles to support her family. Last quarter, her health condition worsened, and she is following up for doctor's advice. Thus, GHCA extended her rental aid till Nov 24 while she recovers.

MANI MALA A/P CHELLADORAI

Mdm Mani Mala, 52, widow, living alone. She suffers from hypertension, diabetes, and high cholesterol, which have left her physically weak and unable to work. Last quarter, she had not yet received a response to her JKM aid application. As a result, GHCA extended her grocery aid.

Mdm. Tanamletchumy, 50, mother of 6. She is a stroke survivor and suffers from heart disease. 4 of her children are married and have their own family commitments. In Sept 24, her daughter secured a full-time job. Therefore, GHCA extended its aid while they adjusted their finances.
